

DO YOU NEED EXTRA HELP WITH YOUR CO-PAYS?

In 2023,¹ you may be eligible to receive brand name prescriptions at low co-pays of either

\$4.30 or **\$10.35**

SEE IF YOU MAY QUALIFY!

- Are you a Medicare beneficiary?
- Do you live in 1 of the 50 states or the District of Columbia?
- Do you have resources below \$9,090 or below \$13,630 if you are married?^{2*}

If you answered “yes” to all 3 questions, you may be eligible for **FULL SUBSIDY/Extra Help**.

You may be eligible for the **PARTIAL SUBSIDY/Extra Help** benefits if you have resources below \$15,160 (\$30,240 for couples).²

*Resources don't include your home, car, household items, or life insurance policies.³

Extra Help is available through the Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) program—a federally funded program that helps reduce monthly premiums, annual deductibles, and cost-sharing for brand and generic drugs.³

The LIS program provides assistance, or subsidies, to certain low-income Medicare beneficiaries to help pay for Part D plan costs.³
